Microsoft 365 Login

Recently, we noticed some issues with logging into Microsoft 365 (Office 365). We have been working with Microsoft and our provisioning partner to resolve the issue. One provision Microsoft asked us to do was to change our domain name that we use to login. We have setup cbseagles.org as the new domain. This means that you will need to login with name@cbseagles.org rather than name@cbseagles.onmicrosoft.com. The change will mean less typing when you sign in or send/receive email.

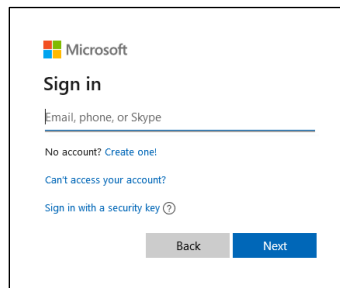
1. First-time Login to Office 365

Note: If you have been using Office 365 (in the Spring of 2020 or more recently), please skip to section 2. Login with Another Username on page 5 of this document.

Microsoft Office 365 Online looks identical in most browsers. These steps will be the same for each browser.

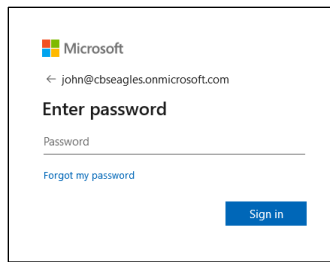
Getting Started:

1. Open the browser (Edge, Chrome, Firefox).
2. Type **portal.office.com** in the address bar and press **Enter**.



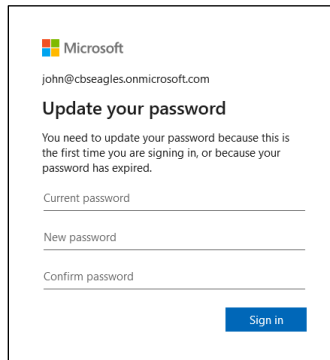
Sign in Screen

3. Enter your Username and click **Next**.
Note: If you do not know your username, please contact Mr. Boyd at the number above.
4. The password screen appears. Type **Romans58** and click **Sign in**.

Note: The first time you login, you will need to change your password.

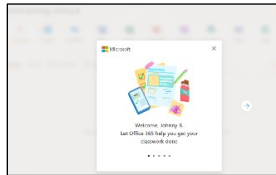


Update password screen


5. Type current password, **Romans58**.
6. Type your new password in the **New password** field.

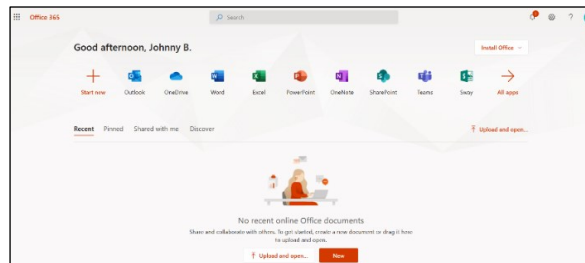
Note: You need to make up a new password. It must be at least 8 characters long, have uppercase lowercase letters, and have a number or symbol.

7. Type it again in the **Confirm password** field and click **Sign in**.

The Navigation Window (Main Menu) for Office 365

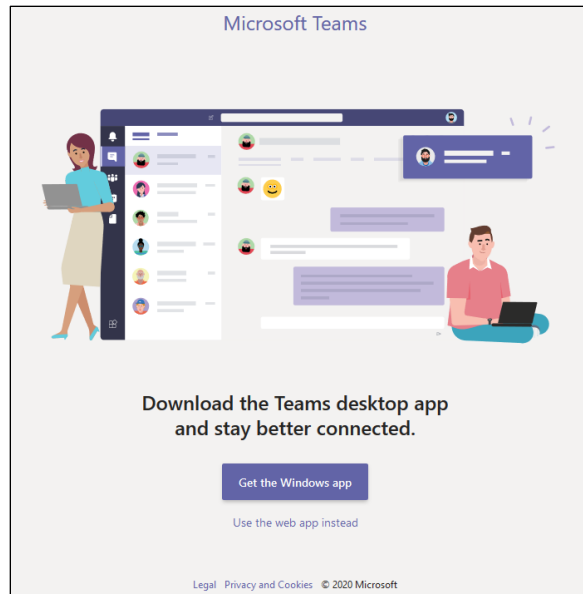
Note: This is where you will access your class(es) in the form of a Team.

Log into Teams

1. Ensure that you are at the Navigation Window (Main Menu) for Office 365.



2. Click on the Teams Icon .

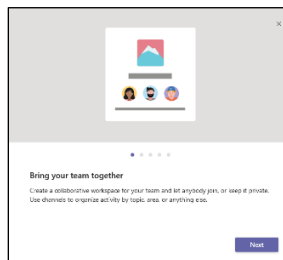


Teams Start Screen

3. For now, click on **Use the web app instead.**

Note: You can use Teams as an online app or a desktop program. You may want to visit this screen again a little later to install the program.

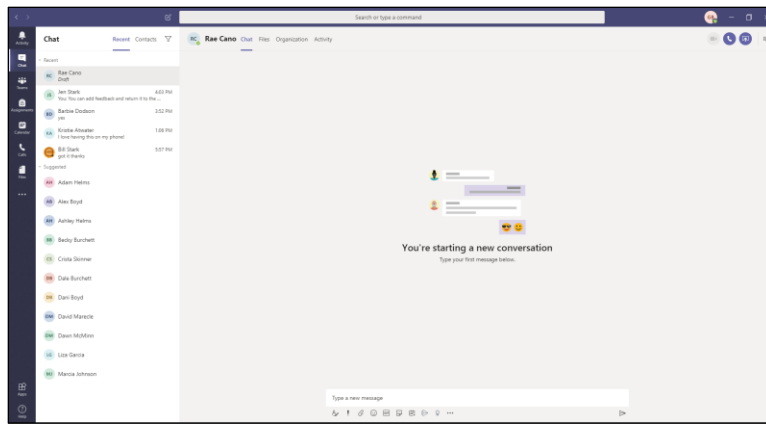
4. You may see another small window with tips.



Teams welcome & tips

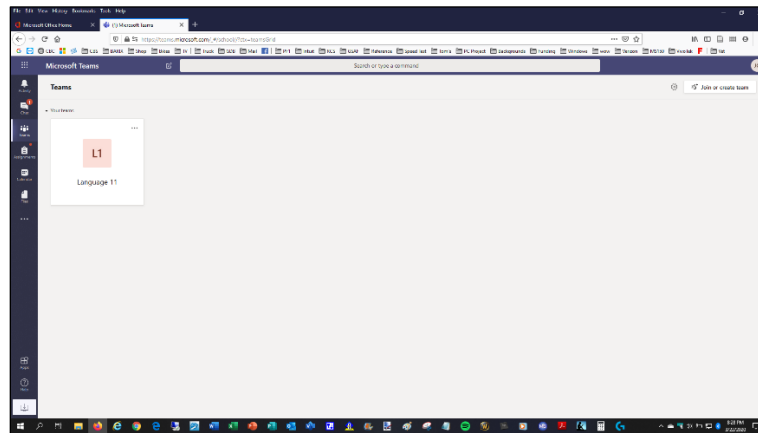
5. Click **Next** to review the tips and click through this window.
6. Click the Team icon of a class where your student is a member.

Note: The first time you enter a Team, you will be in the main chat window.



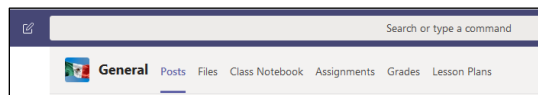
Chat window

7. Click the Teams Icon on the left side .

8. Click on one of the classes that have been assigned to your student.



The Teams Content Menu

Note: This is the screen where your student will spend the majority of their time while working on school assignments. The next section gives brief explanations of each menu option.

- **Posts:** This is where a group chat for the class will be seen. Your student can post input or questions here.
- **Files:** The teacher will store class files here, although, most of the information the student needs will be available in the assignment.
- **Class Notebook:** The teacher may, or may not, use this feature. Some of the high School teachers have set these up.

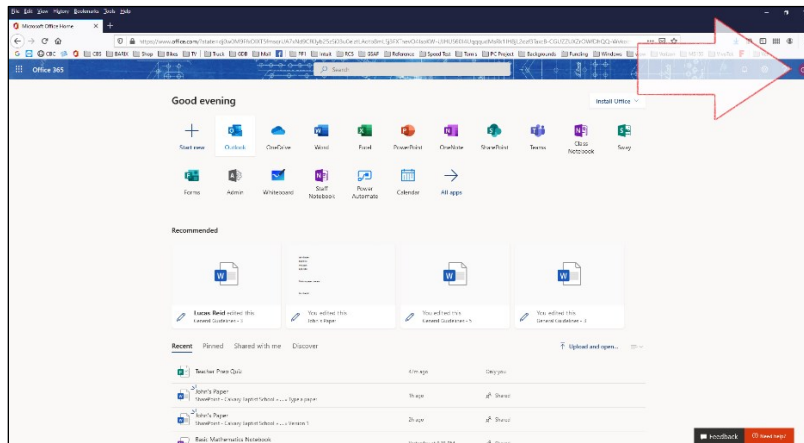
- **Assignments:** Current assignments are listed here with due dates and resources (files, etc.). Not all teachers will use this feature.
- **Grades:** As assignments are turned in, grades will show up here. This may, or may not reflect the current average of grades recorded in the teacher's grade book. If you have questions about grades, contact the teacher.
- **Wiki:** Most teachers will be using the Wiki feature to post information to you, the parent, about the material your student will be covering. Tips on presenting the information or daily guides to what content comes next will be posted here.

2. Login with Another Username

You will need to login to each account assigned to your family. Your list of usernames is at the top of this document. By logging in, you activate each user's account.

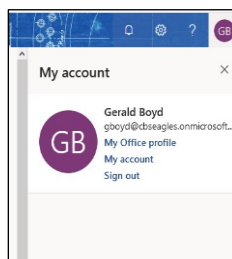
Switching Accounts:

The initials of the user signed in appear in the upper-right corner.



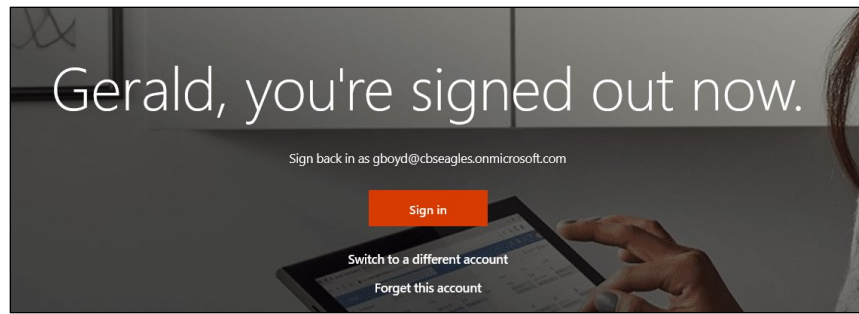
User Account Manager button

1. Click the **User Account Manager Button**.



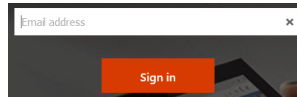
The Account Manager sidebar

2. Click **Sign out**.



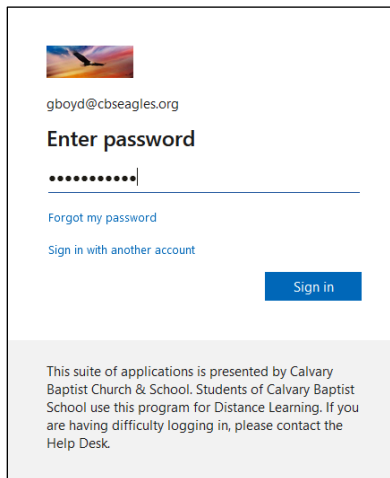
Signed out screen

3. Click **Switch to a different account**.



Email address field

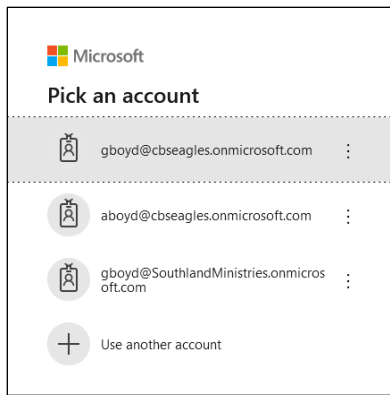
4. Type the **username** of the account you want to switch to and click **Sign in**.

Note: The name of the last user appears in the top of this small screen. In this case you need to choose the **Sign in with another account** option. This seems like an extra step, but it is necessary behind the scenes.

5. Click **Sign in with another account**.



Pick an account window

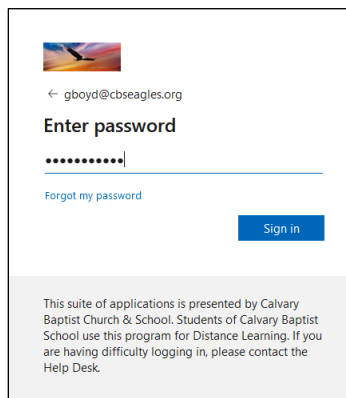
Note: A list of the Office 365 accounts you have already signed into will show up here. Remember to use the cbseagles.org username and not cbseagles.onmicrosoft.com.

6. If the username you want to sign into is in this list, click it.
7. If not, click **Use another account**.



Sign in screen

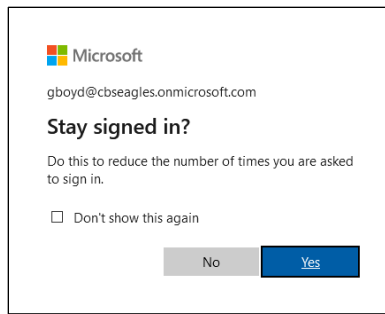
8. Type the **username** again here.



Password dialog

Note: If this is the first time signing into this account, the default password is **Romans58**. You will be prompted to change the password.

9. Type the password, then click **Sign in**.



Note: Switching between accounts seems to reset this dialog box.

10. Click Yes.

Note: When switching between multiple accounts on the same computer, it is a good habit to get into looking at the User Icon (Initials) in the upper-right corner, to be sure that you are logged into the right account.

Repeat Steps 1 -10 in this section for each account. You should activate each account and verify each class Team for Jr and Sr High students. Elementary students will only have one Team.
