Updating the social media accounts does require experience with that, but not more than most folks have who use social media. website updating is quick and easy to learn. I can start calling folks who I think can do these tasks, but it would be much easier for volunteers to reach out to me. We're including the list of jobs again in the newsletter under the stewardship section, please review it and prayerfully consider helping out. What did Esther's uncle say to her as he encouraged her to speak to the king to save her people? "Maybe you were born for such a time as this." Maybe God has done the same in appointing you for a much easier task than Esther's!


