Civil War Trivia

Though the Southern foreign-born population was relatively small, Richmond's immigrants, mostly German, equaled 23% of the native white population in 1860. In Charleston the percentage was higher. Almost a quarter of the people of Mobile and New Orleans were foreign-born when war came. Texas had 421,000 whites, three fourths of them recent immigrants to the state, and a tenth of them foreign-born. This was the only state whose aliens dared oppose the Confederacy, and many Texas Germans fled to the north. Since a fifth of the Texans were German, even Negroes spoke the language, and there were German newspapers, schools and churches.
