

Board of Aldermen Meeting
City of Edgerton, Mo
City Hall
June 6th 2018 at 7:00pm

Present: Mayor Harmer, Aldermen Roan, Cook, Weese and Lammers.

Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Wyatt Stapleton

Approve Minutes: Cook made motion to approve minutes for April and May Weese 2nd motion, all in favor aye motion carries.

Read and approve bills: Cook motioned to approve bills, Lammers 2nd motion, all in favor 3 aye 1 nay motion carries.

Clerk report:

The clerk reported 49 past due letters went out. 0 on payment plan with no residence getting shut off.

Animal clinic only had 6 people showing up bringing in 325.25 and billed for 300.75.

227.35 was collected in water penalties.

Meter reading book was redone to make it more user friendly for clerk and water dept.

A Huge thank you to Steve Kidwell for working with the clerk on setting up a daily back up which has cut down time for the clerk by several hours.

Streets:

Audrey is working with Platte County on our road funds.

The ditches to be cleaned out funded by Fema have suffered another setback due to contractor moving and will not be able to do the project.

Pothole repairs have been started.

Water:

Daily usage 39,950

Water tower was cleaned, washed out and disinfected. We are now waiting on them to finalize the report.

We had a boil advisory that lasted a day and a half.

Sewer:

Our monthly DMR was sent out.

Benson is working on the levee.

Do to blue green algae our BOD level was high last month but they have since gone down.

Parks:

All lights that are out in the park belong to KCPL and they will fix them.

Sidewalk, funded by parks grant, will be started weather pending.

Down tree at ballpark cleaned up.

Sprayed all the parks parking lot.

The mowing has begun. The ones needing gravel will be getting that soon as well.

Police:

The following is the list of calls received for the month—

Aldermen report:

Weese: Next month's meeting will be on the fourth of July can we have the meeting July 3rd, 2018 instead? Everyone agreed to move the meeting to the 3rd.

Citizen Input:

Pioneer day representatives Debbie Phan and Angela Stubbs advised they did get the signed letters from the residence in question that may be bothered by the street dance and provided that to the board.

Debbie proposed to the board a street dance on Aller Street from 10:00 pm to 1:00 am. The board asked Chief Stackhouse on his thoughts and he advised he is fine with the dance and it had already been agreed on the city and pioneer days that if anything does happen it can be shut down. Lammers made a motion to have the street dance on Aller Street from 10:00 pm- 1:00 am, Cook second the motion all in favor aye motion carries. Debbie also stated that they will do the clean up after the dance.

Nancy Montgomery asked what can be done about the weeds on Frank Street? Chief Stackhouse stated letters were just send out.

When waste management delivery the poly carts is there an ordinance on moving your trash cans back up to the house instead of leaving them by the curb? The board advised they will look into it.

Are there any new updates to the building next door? Mayor Harmer advised that Chris Long has stated he will be here this month he has the material and already rented the truck.

Can you post the bills online? The board advised Nancy she can come to city hall and request to see the bank statements at any time and that the board will discuss whether or not to post bills to the website.

Rick Lanham stated he had a question in regard to the new water rate. The board explained the difference in rates for in town and out of town and also the fraction that is in place with the old rate due to billing system is built to round up if you use over the 1000.

Sheryl Hanks stated the weeds at the end of Perrin and Clark is so overgrown and you cannot see anything coming. The board stated the weeds are getting out of control we need to pull ordinance we will need to look at it and maybe have a new one drawn up.

Michelle Hume from the Villa asked how many sewer lines am I getting charged for? The board stated they would have to go back and look at the records and find out what she is getting charged for. Hume advised she has a meeting on Tuesday and would like the answer by then.

Wyatt Stapleton star scout asked the board how eagle projects have been done in the city of Edgerton? The board advised 9. Mayor Harmer asked why is it good for the eagle boys to do projects? Wyatt stated we do projects the cost is free to help out and to keep things looking nice.

Old business:

Flag pole: We have found out the cost to buy and install the new flag pole will be around \$5,000.00 Nancy asked if that was also the cost of removing the old? The board advised no. Lammers asked if the current poles could be modified to make lowering and raising the flag easier? The board tabled the matter to see cost of modifying the current poles.

Midwest storm:

Audrey advised her and Amy will be having a meeting with the owner of the company to finalize payment.

New business:

Holidays: Weese asked the board if we could have the same holidays as the bank and post office? Mayor stated it will have to be looked at again at the end of the year.

Animal Clinic:

When we look at our budget for next year we will make a decision on having the animal clinic or not.

Missing House numbers:

Weese stated a lot of houses do not have numbers on them. The board advised we will go back and look at the ordinances Cory stated he will reach out to Rodney also.

Police: We are still waiting on County to give us the information needed due to they are looking at different options for us.

Pioneer day donation check: Shawn advised that we donate a dumpster for pioneer days we cannot afford to pay for the dumpster and also give a cash donation.

Flood plain Administer training: There is a seminar in Jefferson City September 26 and 27th that Audrey, Amy and Shawn are going to attend and it is free of charge.

Building inspector: Curt Skoog emailed the clerk of the pricing of their services.

Ordinance B- 002 changing the time of board meeting to 6 instead of 7.

1st reading: Weese made motion to accept new ordinance, Roan 2nd motion all in favor aye.

2nd reading: Cook made motion to accept new ordinance, Lammers 2nd all in favor aye motion carries and goes into effect for July's meeting.

Ordinance C-003 No parking on north side of Lewis Street between Oak Street and Collage Street.

1st reading: Lammers made motion to accept new ordinance, Weese 2nd motion all in favor aye.

2nd reading: Roan made motion to accept new ordinance, Lammers 2nd motion all in favor aye motion carries.

A/C: The board stated we need to look into heating and air for city hall. We did put bid notice for 30 days already in the paper with several appointments set up but no show on them and no bids came in. Attorney Gary Collins advised if you put it in for 30 day then you will not need to repost.

Cook made motion to adjourn meeting, Roan 2nd motion all in favor aye motion carries adjourned at 8:20 pm.
