

REGULAR BOARD MEETING
MAY 18, 2012
CITY HALL, 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor James Snook, also present were aldermen Marshall Welch, Staley Snook and Lloyd Bressman, Alderman Charlene Cook was absent.

Jordan Porter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bressman moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as read, Snook seconded, motion carried (3-0)

Snook moved to pay the expenditures as presented, Bressman seconded, motion carried (3-0)

Spiers reported that the siding on city hall was complete, He also advised the board that a letter had been received from Platte County Road and Bridge advising us that the Clark street bridge has serious deficiencies and will need to be replaced within the next few years. A meeting is scheduled with Platte County personnel for May 17th. Spiers then reported that the water tower has a lot of problems and that DNR has sent a list of items to be repaired so we really need to start negotiations for the property for the new tower. Following discussion of the water tower the board decided that we probably need to have a real estate agent involved in the transaction. The clerk will contact Becky Sellars to see if she can act as the agent.

Chris Stackhouse presented the police report. He reported a combined total of 170 hours worked with 18 call outs and 4 tickets issued. The callouts included 4 reports of dogs running at large, 1 theft of art, 2 peace disturbances, 1 harassment, 1 burglary and 1 burglary in progress, 1 report of illegal dumping, 2 child custody reports, 1 ex parte violation, 3 stolen bikes and 1 suspicious person.

T.J. Adkins reported that all grant applications had to be in by June 29th and that everything was almost ready.

Bressman moved to hire Becky Sellars to design and maintain a web site for the city of Edgerton, Snook seconded, motion carried (3-0)

Jeremy Guyer inquired about the status of the water line to his new house. Spiers will contact JMar.

Shilo Osborn completed his Eagle Scout project and painted 22 fire hydrants with the help of a crew that he oversaw.

T.J. asked the clerk to have the parks board meetings taken out of the paper
