

REGULAR BOARD MEETING
NOVEMBER 2 r 2011

The meeting was called to order by Mayor James Snook, also present were aldermen Charlene Cook, Lloyd Bressman, Staley Snook and Marshall Welch. Cook Led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The clerk reported that she had received on bid for the upcoming audit. She is to obtain a second bid.

Spiers reported repairing one water leak. He also advised that another leak was noticed in the riser pipe on the water tower and was repaired. Spiers also noted that the new roof and gutters was finished on city hall

Spiers will be meeting with John Marshal of J-Mar Underground to get an estimate on installing a new four inch water main on oak st.

Chief Bruner reported a combined total of 146 hours with 23 call outs and two tickets issued. The call outs included 17 calls to the trailer park, 3 dogs running at large, 1 destruction of property, 1 illegally parked vehicle and 1 go kart on the city streets.

T.J. Adkins advised that the scoreboard has been erected at the ball park.

Bruner advised the board that an Emergency Management Drill has been scheduled for Edgerton in Sept 2012.
