SMOKING and VAPING POLICY

1.0 NARRATIVE OF MOP

This policy prohibits smoking or vaping in pit area, flight line, any covered, enclosed area and in vicinity of members and children.

2.0 PURPOSE

The Club has a responsibility to ensure members are not exposed to undue risks. Smoking and vaping have been identified as serious health hazards; medical experts have identified this risk extends to passive smoking, i.e. the inhalation of smoke by others. The club respects the rights of members to smoke and vape, however smokers must be mindful of the rights of other members who elect not to smoke or vape.

South Australian legislation (Tobacco and E-Cigarette Products Act 1997) restricts any person from smoking or vaping within ten metres of any restricted area or person. NMAS has adopted this defined area in an equivalent manner.

3.0 DEFINITION

Smoking and Vaping: The inhalation and exhalation of smoke from tobacco or any other substance either using cigarette, pipe, or other device.

Passive Smoking: The inhalation of smoke from persons smoking or vaping.

Covered Area: Any area covered by a roof or structure that provides cover from the weather.

Enclosed Area: Any area which is enclosed by walls of any material.

Child: A persons under the age of 18 years.

Restricted Area: Within 10 metres of any building, structure, child, or person

4.0 POLICY

Members and Visitors to the Club field are not permitted to smoke or vape:

- a. in the pit area.
- b. any of the sheds.
- c. clubhouse.
- d. any covered or enclosed area including verandas.
- e. within ten metres of any child.
- f. Within ten metres of any member who does not wish to inhale passive smoke

5.0 RESPONSIBILITY

It is the responsibility of all members to ensure that these procedures are adhered to.
