PURPOSE

The practice of dropping articles from model aircraft can put members or their models at risk if not conducted in the appropriate manner.

APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS

CASR 101.055 - Hazardous Operation of Model Aircraft

DEFINITION

Bomb Drop: The deliberate dropping of an object from a model aircraft whilst in flight.

POLICY

1. The deliberate dropping of an object from a model aircraft in flight must be done in accordance with CAR 101 (include CAR 101)
2. Prior to dropping an object from a model aircraft it is the responsibility of the pilot flying the model from which the object is to be dropped to inform other fliers on the flight line of his/her intentions to drop the object.
3. If as a result of the dropping of an object from a model aircraft, damage is sustained to a person or property, the liability of compensation will rest with the pilot and owner of the model aircraft from which the object was dropped.

RESPONSIBILITY

It is the responsibility of all members to ensure that these procedures are adhered to.
