Objectives

The primary function of the Chief Flying Instructor is to lead and coordinate with other instructors in the principal role of teaching students to fly model aircraft in accordance standards and requirements of the MAAA wings ratings.

Requirements

As a member of the committee a Working with Children Check Outcome of NOT-PROHIBITED is required

Responsibilities

Engaging in the transfer of knowledge related to flying training through ground education and flying time with students

Duties and tasks

- Coordinate an instructor training roster on behalf of the club
- Conduct periodic meetings of the club flying instructors
- Coordinate students to maximize flying time during training sessions
- Oversee the training progress of Student Pilots
- Officiate at flight testing for Wings ratings
- Oversee the test flying of models

Accountability

The Chief Flying Instructor is accountable to the General Committee

Commitment

- The Chief Flying instructor term of duty runs for 12 months
- The estimated time commitment required for the CFI 3-5 hours per week
- Attendance at officially designated training sessions
- Attendance as elected CFI at each monthly Committee meeting
- Attendance as CFI at monthly General meetings.
