### **Objectives**

The Chief Safety Officer is appointed to oversee on behalf of the club all aspects of flying safety are maintained in accordance with MAAA & CASA requirements.

### **Requirements**

As a member of the committee a Working with Children Check Outcome of NOT-PROHIBITED is required

### **Responsibilities**

- Establish and report to the committee matters of safety relating to the safe operation of models
- Ensure members meet their flying safety obligations
- Present issues and matters of flying safety to members at general meetings
- Acts as or ensures that delegated responsibilities are carried out in the best interests of flying safety and the club

### **Accountability**

The Chief Safety Officer is accountable to the General Committee

Be accountable for Hazard identification, risk assessment and corrective action of all club flying activities.

### **Commitment**

- The Chief Safety Officer term of office runs for one year
- The estimated time commitment required as the Chief Safety Officer is 3-4 hours per week.
- Attendance as elected CSO at each monthly committee meeting
- Attendance as CSO at each General Meeting

### **Assumption**

To meet current day communication requirements, it is assumed that the holder of this position will be in possession of a personal computer and have access to internet facilities.
