

Landmark Victory – The UK Autism Act

The [statutory guidance](#) for the [Autism Act 2009](#) was published on December 17, 2010.

This is a landmark victory following three years of campaigning by the National Autistic Society and their supporters.

This guidance sends a clear message to all local authorities and local NHS Trusts telling them to ensure they are meeting the needs of people with autism.

Now this has been introduced, people can start campaigning locally to make sure that the lives of people with autism are improved
