

MESSAGE FROM CARERS ALLIANCE, NSW

This is a [link to the NSW Upper Housing Inquiry](#) which was established on 13 November, 2013 to inquire into the need for social and affordable housing. Please we urge you to make a submission, it is vital that you do so particularly if you have a family member who will need community housing now or in the future.

The Inquiry must report by **9 September, 2014**

If you are the parent of a person with a disability or a person with a disability who requires community, social or affordable housing it is important that you include in your submission words along these lines:

“I believe that current housing stock which are government assets paid for by the taxpayers of NSW, should not be given to disability service providers because once tenure passes those assets can be then sold by those service provides. This means uncertainty for people needing affordable housing, particularly people with disabilities. People including people with disabilities, need housing in their community and many arger disability service providers have become business regarding the dollar as their prime consideration, not the welfare and well-being of the person with disability. Any government-owned housing stock should be leased at a peppercorn rate that includes a contractual agreement that they be maintained so that they will remain available for disability housing in the community and an asset of the NSW taxpayer.”
