## Black Bear Falls Annual Property Review Checklist

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## **Owners Responsibility**

- Bear boxes
  - o Are they present and in good condition?
- Signage
  - Are only the approved signs properly displayed and in good condition?
  - o Is the 911 Address correct?
- Exterior
  - o Does the cabin need staining or exterior repairs of any kind?
  - Are downspouts properly draining storm water to prevent erosion?
  - o Is there a proper 'hot tub' drain? Is it being used?
  - Are there any trees or landscaping that does not comply with BBF standards?
  - Has there been any encroachment or additions to the cabin or owner related property that extends beyond the owner's property boundary? (there could be exceptions to this)
  - Any 'park grill(s)'? Good condition? Need painting?

## **HOA's Responsibility**

- Common Areas
  - Roadways, parking areas and curbs (look for damage / areas needing repair)
  - Lighting (ensure all lights are operating properly; look for potential tree hazards; look for any repairs needed, including painting)
  - Fencing (look for repairs and/or additions)
  - Security cameras (check for proper operation)
- Clubhouse, pool and pool pump building
  - Inspect roof, gutters and down spouts
  - Inspect exterior (windows, doors and condition of stain)
  - Inspect HVAC
  - Inspect interior (plumbing, lighting, Wi-Fi, appliances, electrical, kitchen, bathrooms and related items)
  - Inspect pool equipment, chairs, fencing, gates, emergency phone, lighting, signage and related items
