kicking for goal meant we were unable to increase the lead going into the half.

We were 2.8-20 heading into the third term; we knew we had another gear to step up our game and we took control and increased our lead to 15 points at three quarter time. It was an even contest in the final 20 minutes; Red Hill pegged back the deficit but midway through the quarter we wrestled it back to a 17 point lead.
