During my association with Don both he and Cheryl have become very close friends, we have had some wonderful holidays with them and made many memorable memories that we will cherish for ever.


Don, somehow we will have to include this gathering in the agenda at our next conference in Hobart, but we would rather have liked to have had you there, with your smile and witty sense of humour.


