

It was announced on Easter Sunday that a generous anonymous donor has gifted the church with a print of the famous painting, "Prince of Peace" by Akaine Kramarik. Scholars and historians have analyzed the painting. They discovered when compared to and overlayed with the shroud of Turin, there is roughly about 90% accuracy and similarity between the two.

Jesus began to speak Akaine Kramarik when she was 4 yrs. old. She had never been to church and neither parent believed in God. She didn't even have a concept of a higher power, but when she was 8 and this "being of unconditional love" told her to paint His picture, she did.

I felt an unbelievable desire to this face I saw, but couldn't get it right, "Akaine said. "I prayed, "If you want me to paint this, bring Him to me.' One day, carpenter came to our door and I just knew this was the model."

From a sketch she drew in under n hour, she creates what is often touted as the most well-known painting of Jesus Christ in the world. The 8-year-old a completed an exquisitely detailed 3'x4' portrait that was bigger than her in under 40 hours. (excerpt from the DailyTrib.com)
