SERMON TEXT- Acts 2:1-21

¹When the day of Pentecost had come, [the apostles] were all together in one place....⁴All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit & began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. ⁵Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. ⁶And at this sound the crowd gathered & was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. ⁷Amazed & astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? ⁸And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? ...in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power." ¹²All were amazed & perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" ¹³But others sneered & said, "They are filled with new wine." ¹⁴But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice & addressed them, "Men of Judea & all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, & listen to what I say. ¹⁵Indeed, these are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is only nine o'clock in the morning. ¹⁶No, this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel: ¹⁷In the last days it will be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, & your sons & your daughters shall prophesy, & your young men shall see visions, & your old men shall dream dreams. ¹⁸Even upon my slaves, both men & women, in those days I will pour out my Spirit; & they shall prophesy.¹⁹And I will show portents in the heaven above & signs on the earth below, blood, & fire, & smoky mist. ²⁰The sun shall be turned to darkness & the moon to blood, before the coming of the Lord's great & glorious day. ²¹Then everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.'"

- 2. Some scholars think that "they" in v1 refers to the 120 disciples in 1:15. How does that interpretation fit with John 20:19-25 (also John 13:1-16)?

EACH OTHER- Sharing & growing with our brothers & sisters in Christ

- 3. In Holy Baptism, the Holy Spirit is poured out on each Christian (*Isaiah 11:2 & footnote;* Acts 2:38); how do you see the Spirit at work in your everyday life? How are you filled with new wine? See Matthew 9:17; John 2:1-11; Ephesians 5:18-19
- 4. The gift of tongues is for proclaiming the gospel (*vv8*, 11), not anything else- & in known, intelligible, languages (not "spiritual Chinese"; *cf.* Agnes Ozman, Charles Fox Parham, *et al.*). Who in your everyday life needs to hear about God's forgiveness, new life, & salvation in Jesus, in plain English? Pray for the Holy Spirit to give you the opportunity, the boldness, & the words.
