SERMON TEXT- Matthew 13:31-33, 44-52

³¹[Jesus] put before [the crowds] another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed that someone took & sowed in his field; ³²it is the smallest of all the seeds, but when it has grown it is the greatest of shrubs & becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come & make nests in its branches." ³³He told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took & mixed in with three measures of flour until all of it was leavened. ⁴⁴The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which someone found & hid; then in his joy he goes & sells all that he has & buys that field. ⁴⁵Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls; ⁴⁶on finding one pearl of great value, he went & sold all that he had & bought it. ⁴⁷Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a net that was thrown into the sea & caught fish of every kind; ⁴⁸when it was full, they drew it ashore, sat down, & put the good into baskets but threw out the bad. ⁴⁹So it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come out & separate the evil from the righteous ⁵⁰and throw them into the furnace of fire, where there will be weeping & gnashing of teeth. ⁵¹Have you understood all this?" They answered, "Yes." ⁵²And he said to them, "Therefore every scribe who has been trained for the kingdom of heaven is like the master of a household who brings out of his treasure what is new & what is old."

LISTENING TO ...

GOD- Christian life is rooted in the Father, Son, & Holy Spirit

- 1. How does the *1 Kings* lesson connect with the *Gospel*, consider esp. the "wisdom" displayed in the tasks of *Matthew 13:33-48*? How does it show a model of what Jesus teaches about? *Hint: look for themes, parallel ideas, inversions, reversals, similarities, extensions, metaphors, actions, vocabulary, grammar, etc.*
- What does *Philippians* 2:5-11 add to vv44-46? How could the baptized Body of Christ be a treasure or pearl? *See Psalm* 8:4-8, 103:1-5; *Matthew* 6:25-33, 10:31; *John* 3:16-17; *Romans* 5:6-11; *Revelation* 21:2; *Small Catechism*: Creed, article 2, available bookofconcord.org

EACH OTHER- Sharing & growing with our brothers & sisters in Christ

- 3. A sharp criticism between "traditional" & "contemporary" congregations is the accusation that one only cares about what is old & the other only about what is new (*cf. v52*)! How are you & your congregation actually guilty of the appropriate charge, of being stuck in its ways to the exclusion of other Christians & pre-Christians? It should be easy to list 15 or more.
- 4. What concrete things could the "other side" actually teach your congregation & enrich its ministry & mission in its neighborhood? Try to match- or exceed- your list in #3.

- 5. Notice in vv47-48 the gospel net brings in "all kinds" of fish at once. How (or when) does your congregation bring in a large crowd of non-members to hear the Word? What opportunities are you missing to help fill the congregation's net? See Matthew 4:19; Acts 2:1-47; 4:29-35; 5:12-16; 1 Corinthians 9:19-23
- 6. God's kingdom comes to us when we believe his word & live godly lives; how can you explain the value of this to someone in world that seems only concerned with immediate, socio-political ends? *See <u>SC</u>: Lord's Prayer*
