#### SERMON TEXT- John 21:1-19

¹After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias; & he showed himself in this way. ...⁴Just after daybreak, Jesus stood on the beach; but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. ⁵Jesus said to them, "Children, you have no fish, have you?" They answered him, "No." ⁶He said to them, "Cast the net to the right side of the boat, & you will find some." So they cast it, & now they were not able to haul it in because there were so many fish. ⁵That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" ... ⁰When they had gone ashore, they saw a charcoal fire there, with fish on it, & bread. ... ¹²Jesus said to them, "Come & have breakfast." Now none of the disciples dared to ask him, "Who are you?" because they knew it was the Lord. ¹³Jesus came & took the bread & gave it to them, & did the same with the fish. ... ¹⁵When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my lambs." ¹⁶A second time he said to him, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" He said to him, "Tend my sheep." ¹¹He said to him the third time, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter felt hurt because he said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" & he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Follow me."

- 4. How are vv1-4 ironic in light of Matthew 4:18-23? The human mind always reverts to previous training/habits. When have you found yourself returning to old ways, despite Gospel, spiritual enlightenment? Note: this isn't really about sins as it's about unproductive patterns- even if they were once beneficial for you.

- 5. Consider *John 6:11 & 13:4-5* alongside *vv9-12*. Once again Jesus serves his disciples (not the other way around, *cf. Matthew 20:25-28*). What makes meal service (*cf. vv15-17*) such a powerful example & symbol for Christian work in the world? Who is your congregation feeding in both senses? Who needs to be fed in your congregation's neighborhood? How can you help?
- 6. God establishes the New Testament pastorate so that the people will hear & receive saving faith (cf. vv15-17, 20:19-29, 13:12-15; Romans 10:13-17; 1 Corinthians 3:5-9; Augsburg Confession V, available bookofconcord.org). List at least 12 ways your pastor feeds you & give thanks to God for them (& maybe tell your pastor, too.)
