

DIXIE JACKSON NIGHT

Dixie Jackson, the woman for whom the annual Arkansas Missions Offering was named, was a beautiful example of living the Gospel. Access to formal biblical training was limited in the town of Dardanelle, Arkansas, where Dixie and her hus-



band James lived and raised their family. But she was passionate to learn and wasted no opportunity to study Scripture on her own. For Mrs. Jackson, living the Gospel meant firmly grounding herself in the Word of God as she raised eight children and served in her church. In 1914, two years after the death of her husband, Mrs. Jackson accepted a full-time position with the Arkansas chapter of the Women's Missionary Union. Dixie Jackson's investment in Arkansas Baptist women and missions lit a passion that has remained vibrant through the years. In 1935, the annual offering was named the Dixie Jackson Offering for State Missions in memory of this incredible woman


