



Smoking & Tobacco Use Policy

To protect and enhance our indoor and outdoor air quality and to contribute to the health and well-being of all employees and patrons, the facilities and the immediate premises of the Batesville Memorial Public Library shall be entirely smoke and tobacco free.

Smoking and the use of any form of nicotine delivery product are prohibited, including but not limited to chewing tobacco, dipping snuff, or electronic cigarettes. Smoking is defined as the holding, carrying, lighting, inhaling and exhaling of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or other lit tobacco products, or of smoke or vapor from an electronic smoking device.

Smoking and tobacco use is prohibited in and around both the Main Library Building and the Library Annex, including benches and lawn areas that are library premises.

Patrons who fail to comply with this policy may be subject to the suspension of their library privileges and/or prohibited from visiting library property.
