Recently an unexpected source informed my understanding of prayer. For the second year the night WMU asked me to prepare BBQ for a meal for homeless men in a downtown ministry. Last year's

I have so much to learn as a **pray-er.** Don't be shocked; be honest. You do too. Where do we learn? How do we learn? What do we learn? I hope to learn soon.

With experience I prepared more BBQ this year and I arrived at the event with more knowledge and less anxiety. While setting up our crew was informed that a trend had developed of struggles in the ministry with men misbehaving. We were asked to be on guard.

Teaching my children the practice of prayer has been an interesting journey, to say the least. We began with the practice of rote prayers and these are good building blocks to create a foundation. Yet when

Preparations were quick and soon the bus arrived with the men for our location. They filed in and I wondered, "Who might be the problem tonight?" A new routine was followed until the men were seated at their tables and the moment for prayer had arrived. A volunteer was quick and the large man stood to pray. I paraphrase, but closely:

"God, thank you for this meal and these good people who have fixed it for us. Help us to act like decent people tonight and try to get along and do right and show thanks for this meal to these people. In Jesus name, amen."

My spoon hovered over the BBQ as I realized, that might be the best prayer I've ever heard. It certainly is appropriate for the season now upon us.

As Easter descends upon us like a meal for homeless people I wonder who among us, if not all of us, stands out to God as the problem people. With our rampant judgement, selfishness, pride, etc. we create more challenges in the Kingdom than harmony. The cross drops in each year, bidding us to come in from the cold of our sinful behaviors. A simple meal of love and forgiveness appeals to the hunger of our hearts. We know what is good for us, even if we do not receive it well all year long.

Standing in the rising sun this Easter I will remember the faithful homeless man and his beautiful prayer. I will thank God for the Easter meal and the Savior who provided it for us. And I will pray again this year we will act like decent people, trying to get along and be thankful for the gift we have received.

And in the shadow of the flower draped cross we will sing: Were you there when he rose up from the grave... Yes we are and may our prayers and lives reflect it.


