**But nothing about his background would have predicted his successes.** He is in the estimation of many people a living, breathing, walking, talking oxymoron of a person. But not to himself.

To MR, success is a choice, one he has chosen and suggests anyone can choose. Says MR, "...you know I'm thinking to myself, man, there are some people who think they can't get into college because they come from an impoverished home or their mom and dad isn't around or they're black or they come from a broken school system. No, no, if you think you can't, then you won't. But if you believe that you can, and you use the right resources, if you want to succeed as badly as you want to breathe, then it is possible."

If you believe you can...if you want to succeed as badly as you want to breathe, then it is possible. I wonder: how many people want PBC to succeed in our mission for Christ as badly as we want to breathe? It's quite a metaphor, but it's perfectly true.


