Series Title: The story of the greatest Story Sermon Title: Week 1: The Bible- it's for you

- 16 years I've been teaching here, from the Bible! For next four weeks, in preparation for ACTS- we are going to take a step back and explore the foundations of BIBLE ITSELF.
   Questions line...
- Why do I need to read the Bible for myself? Isn't it enough to just listen to good teachers? Why do we need to know scripture to know God?
- How did the New Testament come about? Why do we have the books we have, and not others? Why does my aunt's old family Bible have a bunch of books mine doesn't? How long did it take the New Testament to come together, and who made those decisions?
- <u>We call the Bible "God's Word", but just what does that mean?</u> What do we mean when we say Scripture is 'inspired'? Why is it so important to stand firm in the authenticity and authority of scripture?
- What are simple but important concepts of how we- as everyday people- engage scripture on own?
- SCRIPTURE is often called "The greatest story ever told". We are going to look at the STORY of the...
- START WITH concept that is a big deal in pop culture today, the idea of REVELATION (not book!)
  - Reveal parties for baby gender
  - o HGTV show- all the home improvement 'reveals'
  - o Masked singer... show builds to revelation of who is behind the mask
- The idea of Revelation is exciting, and it's something we can relate to. When there is SOME TRUTH that we want to know, but CAN'T know unless someone takes the initiative to REVEAL it to us.
- When it comes to a Biblical worldview- any discussion of scripture itself, the concept of revelation is fundamental and essential.
- AND SO, buckle in, because I'm pulling out the D WORD.. something that can cause people to run from their pastor in fear! Talking about DOCTRINE.

## **†** The DOCTRINE of revelation

- Doctrine isn't really scary word. Simply means a belief. Set of beliefs. Even if we don't realize it, we all have our doctrines that inform how we think, see, and interpret the world around us. When we talk about Biblical Doctrine, we're talking about what we BELIEVE the bible to be saying. Shocker, but things not everybody agrees about!! But regardless of what you believe about the Bible, if it holds any weight at all, it HAS TO BE A REVELATION. It is GOD, the creator, revealing Himself to US, his creation.
- As Creator, God is Holy, separate. As created beings, and we cannot know Him unless He <u>CHOOSES</u> to reveal himself
- Key Biblical concept- God is APART from us. He is infinitely beyond us. Powerful image of this...

**Isaiah 6:1-5** In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. <sup>2</sup> Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered

their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. <sup>3</sup> And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." <sup>4</sup> At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. <sup>5</sup> "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty."

- CHURCH! Temptation of the enemy for us to diminished God! As Isaiah experienced, God is infinitely beyond us, and ON OUR OWN, we cannot hope to know him. AND YET!!!
- God <u>INTENDS</u> to be known by His creation. He has acted in ways to make Himself known.
- If God didn't reveal Himself, then He would be our CREATION, not our creator.
- This is one of the great temptations of mankind, going all the way back to when Moses went up on Mt. Sinai, and in his absence the Israelites made the Golden calf.. we want to shape God to what we want him to be- we want to choose what is true, we want to choose what it is that we WORSHIP...
- True worship demands that God reveal Himself. If He doesn't reveal who He is, we aren't worshipping God, we are worshipping what we have created. This is IDOLATRY.
- GOOD NEWS, central to entire Biblical worldview, is that GOD HAS REVEALED HIMSELF...
   two realities
- God reveals Himself through realities of <u>GENERAL</u> revelation and <u>SPECIAL</u> revelation.
- General revelation: The self-revealed knowledge of God given to all people throughout history regardless of culture, education, or locale.
- This is idea that we, as rational human beings, can see the reality that God exists, and his
  essential nature, through observation of creation.

**Psalm 19:1-4** The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. <sup>2</sup> Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge. <sup>3</sup> They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them. <sup>4</sup> Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. **Romans 1:18-20** The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness, <sup>19</sup> since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. <sup>20</sup> For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

## Evidences of God's general revelation

- Commonly held MORAL understanding
- CS Lewis, 'Mere Christianity'- no matter where you go, through all of history, basic commonly held moral understanding, sense of right and wrong. (EXAMPLES). You may think its okay to steal, but you don't want people stealing from you.
- Not only universal moral sense, but we universally fail to keep it. When we don't, we universally recognize that we should have. BUT WAIT- there are amoral people who don't recognize right and wrong- YES, and where this is, every society has recognized such a person as unhealthy, even dangerous.
- POINT is that the existence of this universal moral code, especially since we fail to keep it,
   DOES NOT ORIGINATE WITH US. It is placed upon us. Creator.
- Concept of <u>BEAUTY</u>

- Art. Music. Nature. Why do we find somethings beautiful, some plain, and some offensive? Where does this come from, especially when this too has universal characteristics. People have all sorts of different tastes in music, but universally recognize concepts of beauty such as harmony. OPPOSITE ALSO TRUE... there is a chord known today as a TRITONE (diminished 5<sup>th</sup>), but for centuries called the 'devils interval' because it gives the listener, universally, a sense of incompletion or foreboding. Often used for suspense, forboding.... Was actually forbidden to be used in music in medieval Europe.
- Evidence of design in NATURE
- Nature cries out that it is designed. Even the 20<sup>th</sup> centuries most ardent atheist, Richard Dawkins, admitted that the core of the human cell argues for a creator.
- He said this in interview with Ben Stein- Expelled. Also in this movie... could be argued that if Darwin could have known what we know today about the complexity of a human cell, he may have rejected his own theories. (if Darwin's cell was a washing machine, today's cell is a cray supercomputer)
- MANY OTHERS- but this only gets us so far. General revelation testifies that God exists, and that he is GOOD, but it tells us nothing of His plan for humanity... THIS LEADS TO OTHER....
- Special/specific revelation: The self-revealed knowledge of God given in history through God's specific actions and interactions with specific people.
- God has revealed Himself through the history of ISRAEL
- God has revealed Himself by the Holy Spirit through the <u>PROPHETS</u>
- Multiple scriptures that speak to this...
- BUT MOST IMPORTANTLY, NT world view
- The object and ultimate expression of God's revelation is JESUS

**Hebrews 1:1-3** In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, <sup>2</sup> but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. <sup>3</sup> The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word.

- CHRIST is the ultimate and complete revelation of God. In John 14 Jesus said "If you know me, you know the father- if you have seen me, you have seen the father"
- Here's where it gets really amazing. In Colossians 1, Paul tells us that the fullness of God's revelation to humanity isn't just Christ, but the miracle- the MYSTERY- that has now been revealed- that through faith, HE GIVES US A NEW LIFE, RESIDE IN US.

**Colossians 1:25-27** I have become its (the church) servant by the commission God gave me to present to you the word of God in its fullness— <sup>26</sup> the mystery that has been kept hidden for ages and generations, but is now disclosed to the Lord's people. <sup>27</sup> To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

- And heres where we are leading today...
- Preality! The chief, authoritative, and objective revelation of Jesus Christ is what we call <u>SCRIPTURE</u>, or the BIBLE.
- HUGE POINT! Scripture IS NOT GOD. But in Scripture we have the testimony ABOUT GOD, FROM GOD. Testimony that points us to JESUS

**John 5:39-40** JESUS: You study the Scriptures diligently because you think that in them you have eternal life. These are the very Scriptures that testify about me, <sup>40</sup> yet you refuse to come to me to have life.

- End with famous verse from Paul's second letter to Timothy- the idea, essential to Christ centered Biblical worldview- that scripture is INSPIRED.
- **2 Timothy 3:16-17** *All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,* <sup>17</sup> *so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.*
- TAKE OUT YOUR BIBLE... HOLD IN HAND...

**TAKEAWAY!** The objective truth of God's revelation, the Gospel, the story of God's Grace in Jesus Christ, the gift of Holy Scripture, the Bible... it is for <u>YOU</u>
