✠ Just what do we mean by "The Lord's Will?"
Romans 12:1-2

- God's will is more about *who we are* and *how we live* than whether or not we should do specific things.
1 Peter 2:15, Philippians 2:13

- To pray "*Lord, show me your will*", is to pray "*Lord, I surrender to your work of change and transformation in my life.*"
1 Thessalonians 4:3a, 5:16-18
