God Will Take Care of It!

Casting all your care upon Him; for He careth for you. 1 Peter 5:7 Trust in Him at all times, ye people, pour out your heart before Him: God is a refuge for us. Psalms 62:8

A few weeks ago while getting ready to go to Sunday morning service, this thought ran threw my mind "God Will Take Care of It". I had not been praying about anything specific, just meditating on the goodness of the Lord. Those words kept repeating over and over in my mind throughout the rest of the day. I challenge you to say these words too and claim it in Jesus name and believe it. I know, it is easy to just say it, but it can be harder to say with a heart full of faith. No matter what you may currently be going through or needing an answer or miracle for, God is ready to assist us with any burden or need. When we decide to give a problem to Him, I imagine God probably says something like "I was just waiting on you to finally give it to me, don't worry, I will take the reigns from here and I can handle it". God knows so well how to speak peace into our souls when we take time to listen. If you are like me, too many times we pray and do all the talking and proceed on with whatever else we need to do for the day. But when we take time to just mediate on the goodness of God, then God can speak to us, but we have to stop and listen, tune out other things on our mind i.e. what we need to make for supper, what we need to pick up at the grocery store, etc. I usually have things constantly flying through my head and I certainly don't trust my mind to remember it all so I keep pen & paper handy & make lots of notes and reminders to myself. It's not unusual for me to be writing myself reminders on a notepad while driving my car. As I pray, my thoughts sometimes wonder to someone I need to call/text or something that needs to be done for an upcoming event, because I was praying about it. I can make a quick note about it, and then go ahead and continue praying without too much of an interruption. Whatever hindrances or distractions you need to remove, do it, to spend quality time with God.

No matter what you are in need of God to take care of for you—issues at your job, a new job, financial blessing, relationship or marriage issues, salvation of your family, family problems, healing in your body, direction in your life, etc. —obey the Lord and do what you can do (i.e. daily prayer, worship, reading the Word, fasting, having faith, paying your tithes, attending church), and bring your needs to the Lord in prayer and let "God Take Care of It".
