

Jím's Journal

March is a bittersweet month of the year for me...my mother's birthday (Nora) is March 1 (she would've been 98 this year) and my grandson's birthday, Elliott Jameson Marshal, is on March 4. When I am in a contemplative mood I look back, but also always look forward. I don't know why, but it's how God has wired me. I was reading a blog from the pastor at my home church in Lexington (Ron Edmondson) the other day and something he wrote gave me inspiration to express what is on my heart. I often find great wis-



dom in looking back in the Old Testament. Jeremiah came to mind when he wrote chapter 24:7 (NKJV): <u>"Then I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am the Lord; and they shall be my people and I will be their</u> <u>God, for they shall return to Me with their whole heart.</u>"

Here God promises His people that they could have a heart to know Him. Isn't that amazing? The Creator God, Elohim, the God who never changes, has promised us that we can have a heart <u>to know Him</u>, <u>not just know about Him</u>. First of all, I pray that God will give ME that kind of heart as your lead-follower, and that He would give our pastors, staff, and leaders that kind of heart. It is when we lean into Him that we feel His comfort and His power. I am convinced there has never been a moment in my lifetime that is more urgent for God's people to have that kind of heart than today! Our world is sin sick and in desperate need of healing. Jeremiah 32:38-40 (NKJV) says, "They shall be my people, and I will be their God; then I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear me forever, for the good of them and their children after them. And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from doing them good; but I will put my fear in their hearts so that they will not depart from me." God also promised His people that not only could we know Him intimately, but also that He would help us carry out that heart in the way they lived, loved, and served. This is more than <u>believing a truth</u>, but it would be <u>living it out</u>! My prayer for our churches and leaders is that God will give that singleness of heart, mind and action to us!

Praying these truths can provide a path that you can look back on and see how God does as He promises. While we all make mistakes, and sometimes fall, as we look ahead, each day we have an opportunity to embrace Him through His Word and through a constant attitude of prayer. May God help us all to live out His truth, His love, His Word, as we accomplish His mission in our Jerusalem.


