CONVERSATIONS WITH GOD: Bible study on the book of Psalms

AIM: To know God through the world He created, through His Word, and through experiences with Him. To gain assurance that God will sustain us through life.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this study is to help us hear God's message every time we read His Word. It is possible to read without hearing. We want to learn to let God speak very personally to us as we read the psalms.

WHAT IS A PSALM? A psalm is a song or poem distinguished by its devotional character and deep piety. It is the faith of the Old testament set to music, a poem springing from an encounter with God. It is worship literature.

To us, poetry must have meter, and it usually rhymes. But the psalms are Hebrew poetry which is not concerned with meter and rhyme but instead uses *parallelisms*. This is where the same thought is expressed in different ways. The psalms also use word pictures, contrasts, and repetitions.
