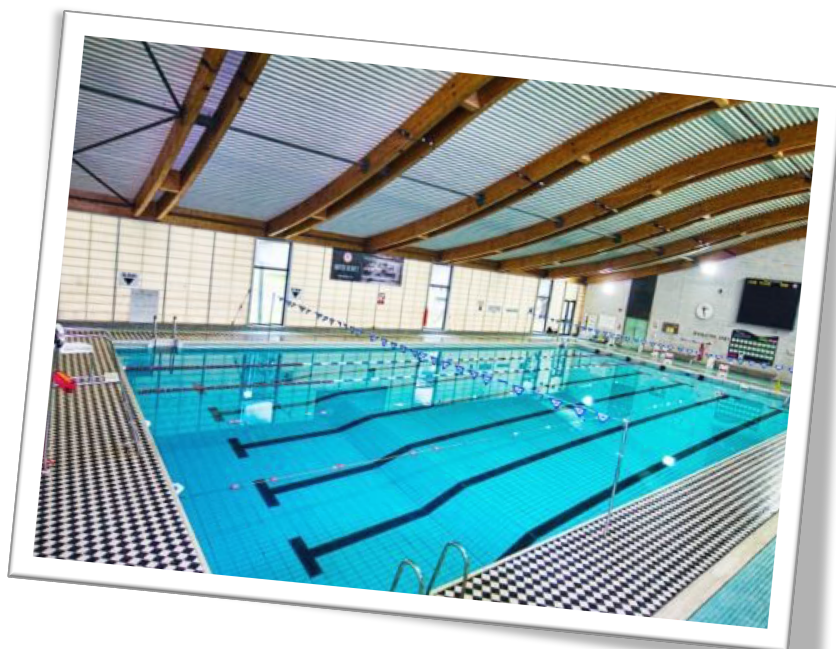

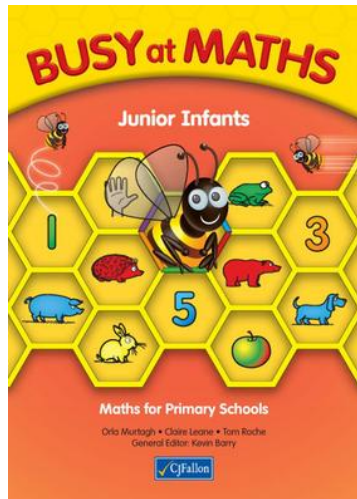
CHEERLEADING

In accordance with the Education and Welfare Act, all absences must be explained by a written note, when the child gets to school.

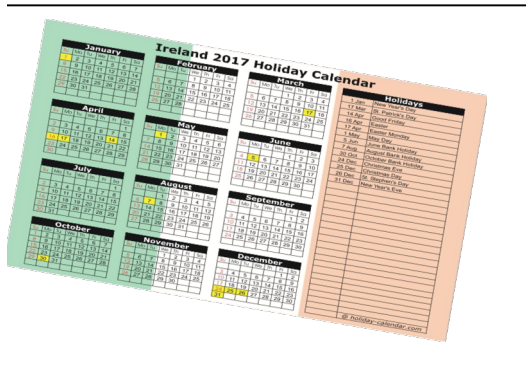
