"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

We are currently right in the middle of the "But God" sermon series. "But God" can be seen throughout the Bible, and the words following that phrase always bring great hope, peace, strength, and encouragement. As you see from the verse above, as well as others (Acts 13:26-31, Ephesians 2:4-5), these two words are at the heart of the gospel. In other places of the Bible, God's protection, provision, healing, presence, and much more follows these two words. This phrase also is rich in describing God's majesty, sovereignty, and power.

As a follower of Jesus, there will be "But God" moments in your life as well. They may not come to you as you hoped or prayed, but God will move in His own way and will. Maybe you have a financial need, health need, relationship need, or other need right now. Be encouraged, when there seems to be no way out, your "but God" moment is coming. And when these moments come, testify of God's great grace and mercy shown to you so that others may hear and be encouraged. The psalmist in Psalms 73 shares the following:

"My flesh and my heart fail; but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever...But it is good for me to draw near to God; I have put my trust in the Lord God, that I may declare all Your good works"
