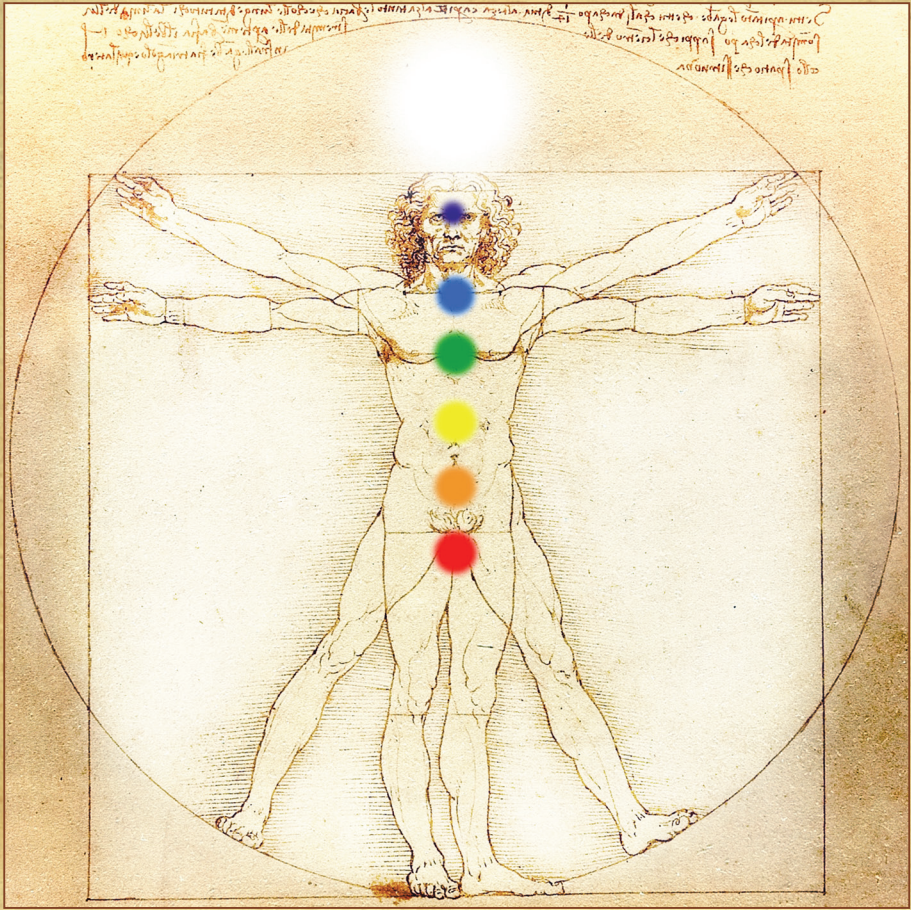

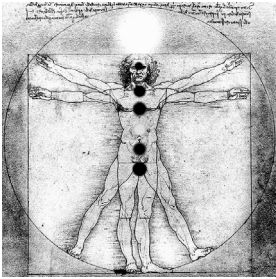
The Great Lakes Retreat

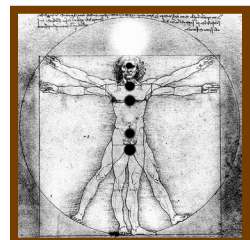

The exercises appeal to the neuroplasticity of the brain and are fashioned on postures similar to Yoga and Qigong. Although many of the postures may be similar to Yoga and Qigong, the intent is NOT to teach Yoga or Qigong, but to rather, draw on the mind/body connection, balance and flexibility that are inherent in these practices. The movements have been adapted to work with all levels of ability. This workshop is for all levels. **Dr. Antonio Sieira**, holds degrees in psychology, special education, metaphysical sciences and religious studies, having a Ph.D., M.A. and M.Div., Dr. Sieira is a professional member of the American Hypnosis Association and holds certification from the AHA as a Past-Life Regression Therapist, Smoking Cessation Therapist and a Weight-Loss Therapist. 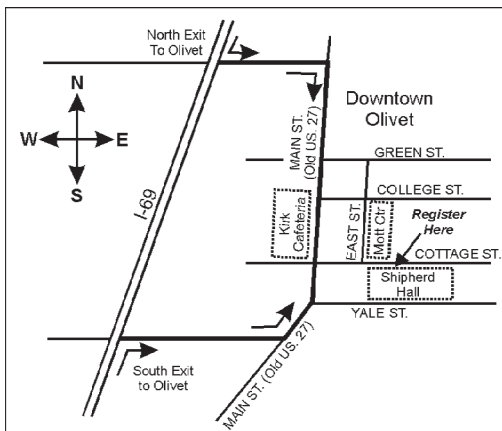
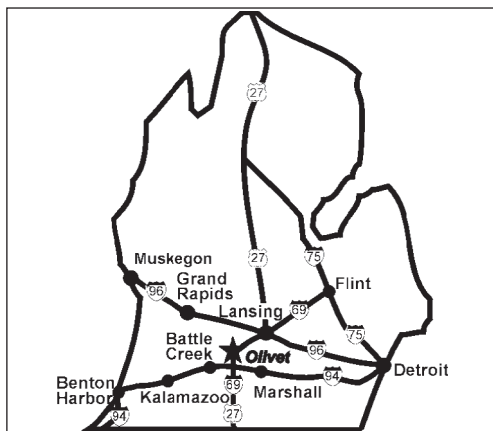
Directions

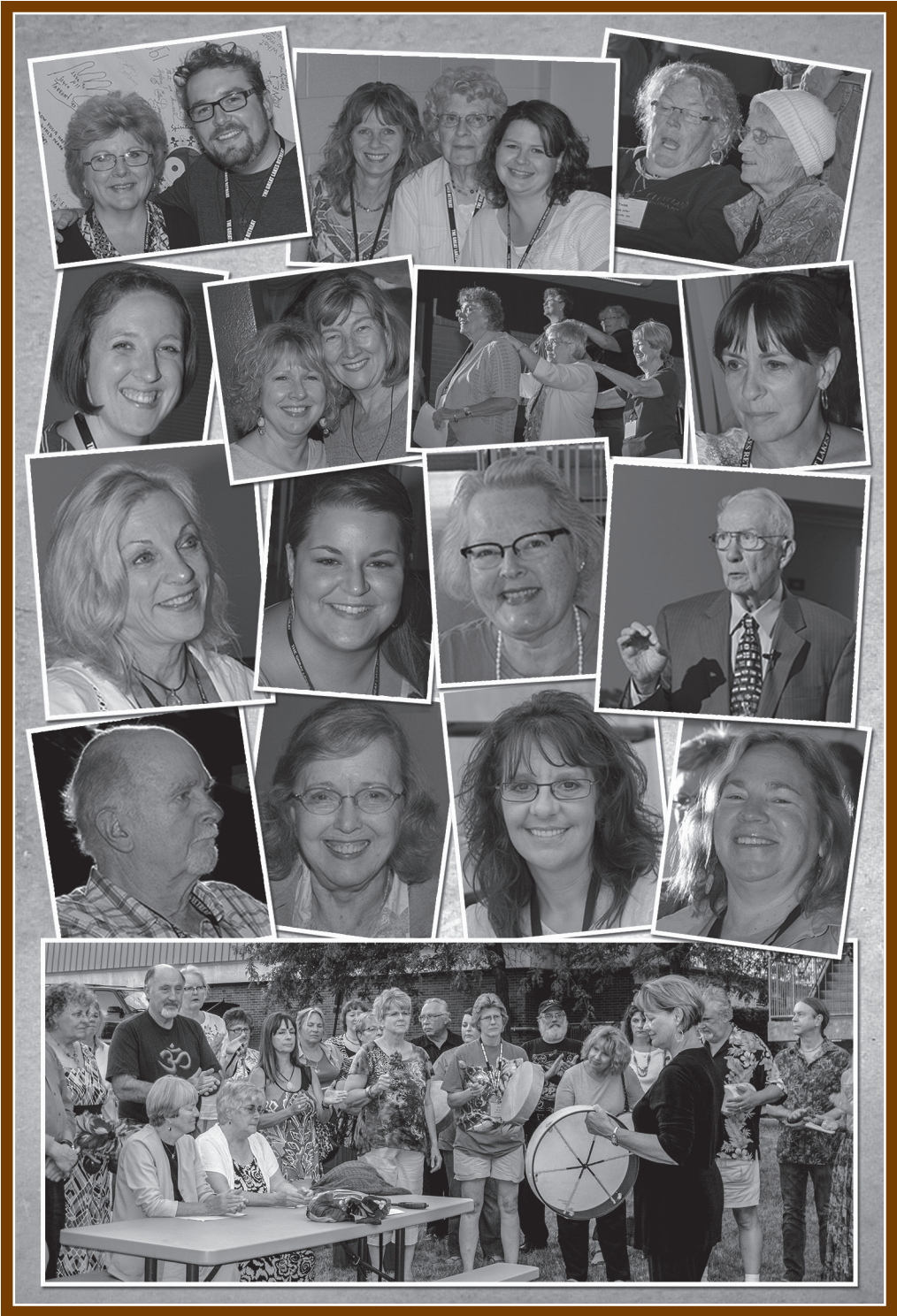

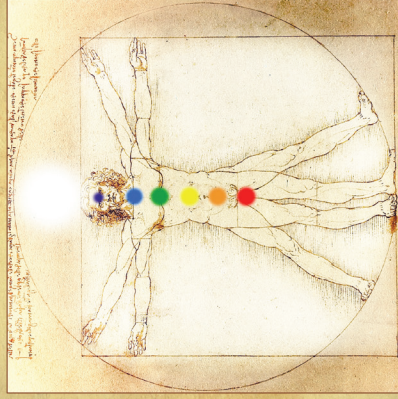
