Pill bottle ministry - Place your clean, empty pill bottles in the box underneath the sign-in table.

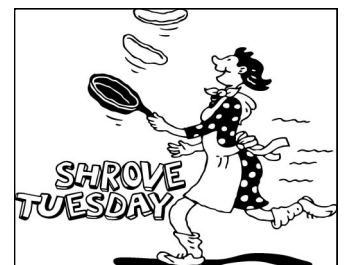
