Today's Offertory Anthem was written by the prolific Fanny Crosby in 1868. Though blind, she was a mission worker, poet, lyricist, and composer. She wrote more than 8,000 hymns and gospel songs, with more than 100 million copies printed. She is also known for her teaching and her rescue mission work. By the end of the 19th century, hers was a household name. Today's hymn, *Pass Me Not, O Gentle Savior*, was set to music by William Howard Doane. Crosby's best known hymns include this one plus *Blessed Assurance, To God Be the Glory*, and *Jesus is Tenderly Calling You Home*.
