Dear Parents,

This week I have had the opportunity to attend 3 days of professional learning working with principals and leadership teams from across Gippsland building understanding of best practice in Koorie Education. In East Gippsland we are lucky to have so many families that have a cultural and historical link to the land we live on. The message I brought home with me is there is so much to learn from Our First Australians if only we choose to listen to what they have to say. I am looking forward to continuing the learning journey with Aboriginal students and families.

The start of this term has been quite challenging with the number of COVID cases in the community rising and in addition to this the cough, cold, and flu season is upon us. A number of staff have been absent over the past few weeks and we are trying to maintain classes to be as normal as possible. During this time we ask that parents keep a careful watch on their children and be aware of signs of illnesses that can spread across the school. If your child has a cough, runny nose, temperature or other symptoms of a cold please keep them at home until symptoms have ceased regardless of whether they have tested negative to a COVID-19 test. Please remember that children returning to school after a cold or COVID-19 must be symptom free. Symptoms may last longer than the prescribed 7 day isolation period. If students are attending school or become unwell while at school, parents will be contacted and must collect them from the sick bay as soon as possible. We thank you for your support and hope that this next stage passes quickly.

I am looking forward to being back at school on Friday and will see you at assembly.
