Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you so much for helping keep everyone healthy this week and for keeping kids home when they are not well. 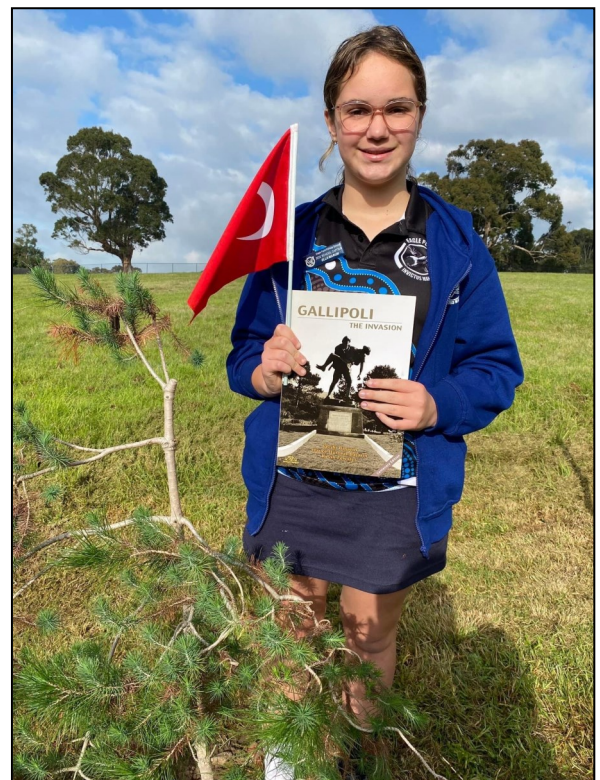
