

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you so much for helping keep everyone healthy this week and for keeping kids home when they are not well. This has been for the benefit of students as we are seeing a slower rate of kids catching colds and also for the staff. It is extremely difficult at the moment to find relief staff if teachers or education support staff are unwell so keeping unwell students at home helps me keep the staff in the classrooms.

Next week our Strategic Review begins with the panel meeting on Monday 6th June. On this day the school presents our achievements over the past 4 years and outlines the goals that were set and how they were achieved. 
