Dear Parents,

Thank you to the parents and students who have made themselves available to meet and talk with our Strategic Review panel over the past week. The final day of the review was due to be Wednesday 15th June but this has been postponed until Tuesday 21st June. The review process is an in-depth look of the school's priorities and processes. A final report will be prepared by the review team which will allow us to map and plan the next 4 years of improvement in the school.

Reconciliation Week was recognised this year during the week of 27th May-3rd June. Due to an overflowing school week we had decided to hold a celebration day on Friday 17th June. The student leadership team have been busy planning activities for the school top enjoy. The day will start with assembly at 9:05am and then students will work in their class group to decorate their T-Shirts using the message "Be Brave, Make Change" as their inspiration.
