#### **Parking**

#### Take care

We are aware of a variety of viruses floating around our community still. Each child should have brought home another box of RA tests. Some children did comment about how many they already had at home. Please pass these tests onto family members (particularly the elderly) neighbours and friends if you feel the need. It is important that children are still doing the tests whenever a symptom presents before attending school, so ensure you are

protecting your family first. It is also a requirement that all family members living with a positive member must test 5 times of the 7 from the week of isolation.

#### <u>Masks</u>

It is a requirement that everyone above the age of 8 travelling on public transport wears a mask. Therefore, we are reminding children who are bus travellers that they must wear a mask to and from school each day. Please get in contact with the school if you need help acquiring masks for this purpose. At this stage it is a recommendation that masks are worn indoors.
