## Grade 3 –6 Maths Competition

This year, we are inviting students from years 3 to 6 to take part in a maths competition. The competition, named Kangourou sans Frontières (KSF), is administered by the Australian Math Trust.

It is an online, multiple-choice competition with 30 questions for senior primary and 24 questions for middle primary, with a time limit of 60 minutes.

The competition will take place on Thursday 29 March and costs \$10. The cost of \$10 will automatically include students in a second maths competition in August.
