Dear Parents and Carers,

The students look wonderful today with their crazy hair! Thank you to all the parents and students for getting in the swing of having some fun. There are always so many amazing ideas and I am always impressed with the creativity. This year we are trialling a new way of running social and fundraising events. Each term, 2 classes will plan 3 events, they could be fundraisers, recognising special days or interesting lunches. Our School and House Captains will be visiting each class this week to spark conversations on what we are fundraising for. This is something that is definitely not OK. During class meetings this week we will be discussing what a put down is, and how teasing others can affect their confidence. Many students are struggling with low resilience at the moment as are many adults in our community and 'having a joke' at their expense is not helpful. Could families please continue this discussion at home over the next few weeks so we can reinforce using positive statements or perhaps saying nothing at all.


