Dear Parents and Carers,

If you are aware of any families looking to enrol students in school for the 2024 school year now is the time to make contact with the school to register and complete an application to enrol. The enrolment policy has been updated this year and applications for enrolment are now open in Term 2 which is earlier than other years. Parents contact the school/s of their choice and request an application form, the form is completed and returned to the school before 23rd June. From early Term 3 families will be contacted with an offer to enrol. If Eagle Point Primary School is the closest school to the student's home address, they will be guaranteed a place at this school. Students from other school zones are able to complete an expression of interest for Eagle Point PS and we will be able to accept enrolments if we have places available. Please contact me if you have any questions regarding school zones and enrolments as it can seem a little daunting.

The school will be holding an Open Day for all families of current and future students on Tuesday 23rd May from 9-1:30pm. The students are looking forward to having parents, grandparents, friends and other family members come to school to see what goes on in a normal school day. New and future families are encouraged to come along to see what Eagle Point Primary School has on offer. Invitations are being sent out through kindergartens and child-care centres and a copy is in this newsletter.

We are looking to start a new program at school where students are paired with a community member for 1 session a week to have time together to follow an area of interest. This might be playing cards, cooking, playing board games, craft activities, kicking the footy, playing in the sandpit or a variety of activities that you both might share. We are hoping there might be a parent, grandparent, family member or community member out there with an hour a week to build a friendship with some of our students who might need a bit of extra care right now. Please contact the office, Meagan Bradbury or myself if you would like more information.

Over the next few weeks, I am going to begin providing some information about Choice Theory, the philosophy and how we use it within the school community. Each year we hold a Basic Intensive course which all staff who work at Eagle Point PS attend. This training is also open to parents if interested. Please speak with one of our staff if you would like to learn more.

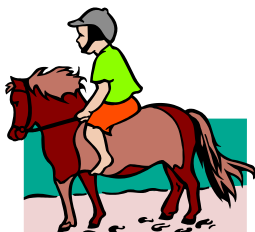
