Dear Parents,

Last Wednesday staff and students enjoyed a lovely walk during the annual Walk to School day. Mrs Bateson supervised the group leaving from the west end of town and I had the pleasure of meeting the group from the east. Together, over 50 students joined in the walks. It was lovely to see the older children being wonderful role models for the younger children, reminding them how to look for cars when crossing roads and staying on the paths. Breakfast Club was very well attended that day with the brisk morning air helping their appetites. Thank you to the parents who came along with us, it was lovely to chat as well as the extra eyes on kids.

There is information about school photos in this newsletter which will be important to read as we have changed photographers this year and the process is slightly different. This year all students will be photographed individually as well with their siblings, classes, leadership groups and whole school. Parents are not required to pre-order photos as each child will receive a form on the day with an individual code. This code is entered into the photographer's website and then you will receive a text message to notify you when photos are ready for viewing. You will be able to see the photos taken of your child/ren and decide which ones to keep.

This Friday is National Sorry Day, which is a day to acknowledge the strength of Stolen Generations Survivors and reflect on how we can all play a part in the healing process for our people and nation. While this date carries great significance for the Stolen Generations and other Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, it is also commemorated by Australians right around the country.

Reconciliation Week begins on Saturday 27th May through to 3rd June. The dates for NRW remain the same each year; 27 May to 3 June. These dates commemorate two significant milestones in the reconciliation journey— the successful 1967 referendum, and the High Court Mabo decision respectively. The theme for National Reconciliation Week 2023, **Be a Voice for Generations**, encourages all Australians to be a voice for reconciliation in tangible ways in our everyday lives – where we live, work and socialise.

Students will be learning about and reflecting on these important occasions this week and the school will be holding a Reconciliation Assembly at 9:15am Monday 29th May. Parents and community members are invited to join us for this assembly.
