#### Dear Parents,

Our Grade 5 & 6 students are gearing up ready to set off to Falls Creek next week for their snow camp. I am sure the families and students appreciate the work that you are doing to ensure all students have access to this amazing opportunity. Students will need to be at school at 7:30am on Tuesday morning ready to catch the bus. The students are due to return on Friday afternoon, the exact time will be confirmed when the bus is on the way.

Parent/Student/Teacher interviews will be held on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June from 3:45-6:30pm and Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> June from 8:15am-1:00pm. To book interviews, please go to the ueducateus app and select Events from the main menu. From Events, select Interviews then select the teacher you need to meet with. The available time slots will be visible, click on a time slot and confirm the booking. Interviews will be for 10 minutes and students are expected to attend. As teachers will be engaged in interviews during the day on Friday, there will be no classes for students although students will be marked as present for the day when parents attend the interviews. Please contact Anna Duncan or the office if you have any questions or need assistance to make a booking.

Our school uses the Ueducateus app to communicate with families, provide permissions for camps and excursions, reporting to parents, recording attendance along with many other uses. The program designers have released a new updated version of the app and the current one will be retired very soon. It is important that all parents download the new version of the app and log in using your current log in details. If you have forgotten your log in information, please contact the office and we can provide this to you. If you have forgotten your password, this is available through the 'I forgot my password' link. There are detailed instructions on how to do this later in the newsletter.

School photos will be being held on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June for all students and staff. Students will need to wear correct school uniform on this day, Grade 6's may wear their graduation shirts if they choose. Hair needs to be neat and tidy, no colour. All siblings will have a photo together which will be available to purchase from the website in addition to individual, class and whole school photos.

The date for the next round of the winter sports soccer competition has been changed to Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June so that our team is able to play. Then original date was the Thursday during our camp but luckily, all schools involved have agreed to play on the Monday instead. Thank you to Mrs Simpson and Dean for their organisation, training and enthusiasm with this.




