### Dear Parents,

This term has just flown by and already we are preparing for the school holidays. This week is very busy with student semester reports due to be released on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June and followed by Parent Student Teacher interviews on Thursday afternoon and throughout the day on Friday. Due to parent teacher interviews, there are no classes for students on Friday but we are expecting students to attend the interviews with parents. Student semester reports are released from the ueducateus app. If you are not connected or have not yet changed over to the new version of the app, please contact the office for assistance if needed.

The school has made a commitment to becoming a Respectful and Respectful Relationships school and staff have been learning together and with an external consultant to develop plans and deepening our understanding of the curriculum. Students have been engaging in weekly lessons based on this topic since the beginning of 2022 and over time have been building the depth of their understanding. The curriculum is provided from Dept Education and is an endorsed program with the Schools Mental Health and Wellbeing menu.

The Resilience, Rights and Respectful Relationships learning materials have been designed for teachers in primary and secondary schools to develop students' social, emotional and positive relationship skills. Efforts to promote social and emotional skills and positive gender norms in children and young people has been shown to improve health related outcomes and subjective wellbeing. It also reduces antisocial behaviours including engagement in gender-related violence.

The Resilience, Rights and Respectful Relationships (RRRR) learning materials cover eight topics of Social and Emotional Learning across all levels of primary and secondary education: Emotional Literacy; Personal Strengths; Positive Coping; Problem Solving; Stress Management; Help Seeking; Gender and Identity; and Positive Gender Relationships.

The school has developed a commitment statement which has been approved by school council.

Eagle Point Primary School is a Respectful Relationships school.

We are committed to promoting and modelling gender equity, respect and positive interactions between students, staff, families, visitors and the wider community.

We believe that the attitude and behaviour of young people towards Respectful Relationships can bring about change.

We all have the responsibility to provide a safe environment where education can take place.

We believe everyone has the right to feel respected, included and valued in order to develop generational change.

We acknowledge that the school community will continually evolve as we build our knowledge around Respectful Relationships.

Eagle Point Primary School will celebrate successes with our school community, creating a culture free from family violence and gender equity.


