Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to school for term 3. Term 3 is such an important term of school, students have settled into classes, routines are known and understood, resilience has been a focus this year so students are primed ready for a solid period of learning. Please ensure students attend school as many days as possible, if they are very unwell such as temperature, vomiting, mucus etc please keep them home until they are well enough for school. If students are attending school with a cough or runny nose, they will be asked to wear a mask.

Lunch orders begin again on Thursday this week. Lunches will be coming from the Paynesville Bakery and will be delivered to school in time for lunch. Please ensure that students know to place lunch orders in the plastic envelope in the classroom before 9:30am or they will miss out on lunch.

On Monday 7th August Grades 3-6 will be heading to Howitt Park for our school Athletics Carnival. Students will travel by bus leaving school close to 9am and compete in a variety of athletics events including running, throwing and jumping events. Students can qualify for the Eagle Point PS athletics team which will go on to compete at District level. We are looking for parent volunteers to assist us on the day. No experience necessary as they will be assisting staff to run the events, rake jump pits, record placings etc. If you or someone you know has a few hours available on the day, please contact the office or your child's classroom teacher. Thank you in advance for the assistance.

Prep (Foundation year) student enrolments are currently being accepted. This year a new state-wide timeline has been introduced. Application for enrolment are completed by parents looking to enrol students at a school. This does not have to be your closest school. The closing date for applications is Friday 28th July 2023. Enrolment places are offered to students in the following order, 1 students who live within the school's designated catchment area, 2 students who have a sibling at the school currently and then 3 students who live outside the catchment area and who do not have a sibling currently enrolled. Enrolment will be offered to families from Monday 31st July and transition starting in early November. Please contact the office for enrolment enquiries and for application/enrolment packs.

Book Week will be celebrated on 19th-25th August this year and we will be holding our annual Book Week Dress Up Parade during this week. Students and parents are invited to come dressed as a character from a book. The parade is held at 9:15am in the assembly area. The day will be announced once confirmed.

Child Care Subsidy Fact Sheet



More families can now access cheaper child care with TheirCare!

- ▶ Families who were previously not eligible for CCS may now be eligible.
- ▶ A higher rate of CCS is available for most families that do access CCS.

From 10 July 2023, the Australian Government is changing the Child Care Subsidy (CCS).

What you need to know:

- The family income limit to be eligible for CCS is increasing from \$356,756 to \$530,000 per annum.
- The maximum amount of CCS is increasing from 85% to 90% for families earning \$80,000 or less.
- Families earning between \$80,000 and \$530,000 will receive an increased CCS rate.
- Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander children can get at least 36 subsidised hours of early childhood education and care per fortnight, regardless of their family's activity level.

What you need to do:

- **Not currently registered for CCS?** If your family earns below \$530,000, you may be entitled to CCS from 10 July. You should check your eligibility now. Create a Centrelink online account through myGov or the Express Plus Centrelink mobile app.
- **Already get CCS?** You don't need to do anything to get the new rates. Services Australia will apply CCS changes automatically for you from 10 July.
- **Do you have an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander child?** You can access at least 36 hours of subsidised care per fortnight, by contacting Services Australia on 136 150 to update your child's CCS details. It is voluntary for you to tell Services Australia this.
- **Need extra support with child care fees?** If you are eligible for CCS and meet certain criteria you may also be eligible for Additional Child Care Subsidy

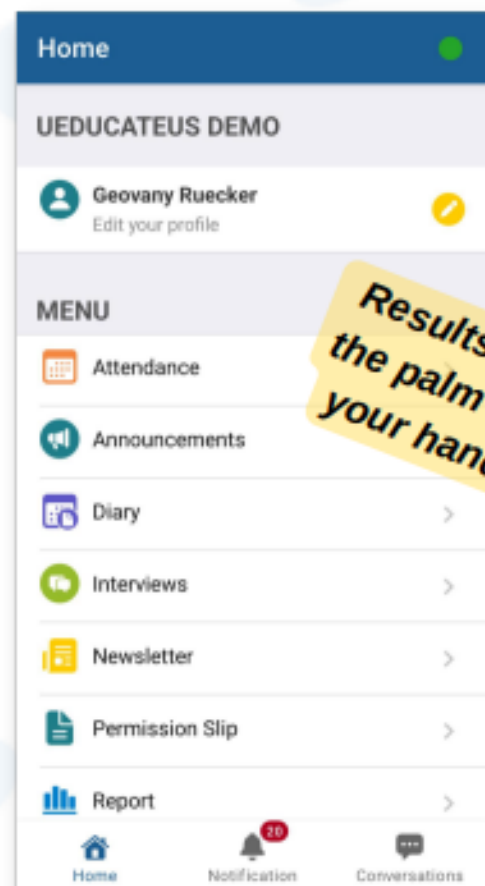
