Operation Christmas Child

What is Operation Christmas Child?

Operation Christmas Child is where shoeboxes are filled and sent to children in need in other countries. If you want to join in, all you need to do is fill up a shoebox from home or collect one from room 7.

What do I put in my shoebox?

You can choose to pack a shoebox for a girl or boy, ages 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14. Place items for the child into the box and label with boy or girl and the age group. Please only pack new items that are good quality, so they last longer for your child to enjoy. Below are some examples of what to pack.

- School supplies Notebook, pencils.
- Personal hygiene items Covered toothbrush, hairbrush.
- A WOW item and toys A fun, quality toy that kids can use.
- Art/craft supplies Colouring books, sketch pads.
- Clothing/accessories T-shirts, hats, sunglasses.
- A personal note Don't worry about writing in a different language.

What not to include in a shoebox

- Food (Iollies, chewing gum, vitamins, seeds, medications)
- Liquid (water, toothpaste, soap dispensers, lotions)
- Lip gloss
- War related items (toy guns, military figures, camouflage)
- Breakables or glass items (like snow globes)
- Aerosol cans
- Scary items
- Damaged/used items
- Gambling items


