Dear Parents and Carers,

On Monday, staff engaged in a full day of professional learning. The morning session was with Jeff Steedman from Riviera Counselling who is our main live source of learning in our Choice Theory journey. We reviewed the difference between Reality Therapy and Choice Theory and how one is linked to the other. My main reminder from this is the importance of building authentic relationships between staff and staff, staff and students and staff and parents as this is the foundation of Choice Theory. We then discussed the current framework we use for behavior reflections WDEP. This stands for What do you want, What are you currently Doing to achieve this, Evaluate these behaviors and how well they are working and the create a Plan to use if this situation arises again. We were introduced to an extension of this framework, WDDEEPF which is used when behaviors are impacting the safety of other people or on the effectiveness of the work to be done. Staff will be practicing using these frameworks during professional learning meetings over the next few weeks.

During the middle session of the day, teaching staff explored using rich mentor texts to develop students passion and skills as writers. Education support staff watched a webinar from Sue Larkey focusing on strategies that can be introduced to set up classrooms for success by all students. In the afternoon, we visited Krowathunkooloong, The Keeping Place Bairnsdale to extend our understanding of our local aboriginal history and culture.

Congratulations to the 2024 student leadership group who were announced at assembly on Friday. These students will meet regularly throughout the year to provide feedback to the School Improvement Team and lead activities that develop our school values.

Maintenance Person Wanted


