Description: A Blended Worship Instrumentalist practices music selected for use in worship and then plays that music to assist people in worshiping God. Many different instrumentalists can use their talents: guitar, bass guitar, flute, clarinet, drums, violin, saxophone, and many others.

Responsibilities:

The Blended Worship Instrumentalists:

- 1. Are put on a rotation schedule, playing approximately once every 5 or 6 weeks.
- 2. Attend the rehearsal (generally Thursday evenings at 7:00 PM) for the scheduled Sunday.
- 3. Practice music on own as needed.
- 4. Play for both blended services (9:30 & 11:00) when scheduled.
- 5. Use their musical ability to praise God.

Time Commitment:

- 5 hours every other month
- Minimum 1-year commitment

Relationships: The Blended Worship Instrumentalists work with and respect one another, any singers, the piano player, and the sound technician under the guidance and direction of the Worship Pastor.

Training: Ongoing spiritual training is provided by the Worship Pastor through devotions at the beginning of practices. Further training will be provided as opportunity arises.
