Chairman

Mission Statement: In His Word Jesus directs us, "go and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19); and He has given us the Gospel, which "is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes" (Romans 1:17); therefore, Trinity Ev. Lutheran Church reaches out with the Gospel to bring others to Christ through Outreach Ministry.

Description: The Chairman of the Outreach Board is elected by the voters to his position. He serves as the person in charge of board meetings and also serves as a member on the Coordinating Council.

Qualifications:

- God has set forth the qualifications for church leaders in 1Timothy 3:8-10, 12-13:
 - worthy of respect = has the confidence of the congregation
 - sincere = speaks truthfully
 - not indulging in much wine = uses alcohol in moderation; self-controlled
 - not pursuing dishonest gain = honest
 - keeps hold of deep truths of the faith = knowledgeable of the truths of God's Word
 - keeps hold with a clear conscience = believes the truth of God's Word
 - tested = sets a good example
 - nothing against him = good reputation
 - husband of one wife = morally upright
 - manages his children well = faithful father
 - manages his household well = faithful caretaker of his family
- Demonstrates Christian leadership skills

Responsibilities:

- 1. Develop agendas for Board of Outreach meetings.
- 2. Determine leadership for devotions and prayers.
- 3. Facilitate/lead meetings.
- 4. Ensure that the board continually refers to and upholds the Outreach plans.
- 5. Ensure that the board supports and empowers the ministries assigned to it.
- 6. Initiate and encourage new ideas.
- 7. Submit to the Coordinating Council:
 - monthly reports on the board's activities and ministries.
 - quarterly priorities and progress in meeting them.
- 8. Communicate effectively and regularly with the Board of Outreach members outside of meetings.
- 9. Attend and participate in Coordinating Council meetings.
- 10. Embrace, uphold, and model equipping ministry.
- 11. Champion the plans and ministries of the Outreach Board.

Time Commitment:

- 7 hours per month for meetings and assigned tasks
- Once elected as Chairman, he serves in this position for the remainder of his board term

Relationships: The Chairman of the Board of Outreach works as a team with board members and the Staff Minister; works with the Coordinating Council.

Training: Board members are provided with training through the yearly board retreat, and other ongoing leadership development opportunities.
