Description: The PMM Discovery Guide assists members with their discovery process through means of a personal interview (guided discovery session). The guide will help the member understand his/her SHAPED profile and help the member find a good ministry fit.

- Able to work independently and reliable

- Demonstrates good interview skills
- Has participated in the Discovery Class
- Understands that confidentiality is a MUST

Responsibilities:

- 1. Personal Development
 - a. Take the Discovery Guide Training Class.
 - b. Learn and understand the fundamentals of all Trinity's ministries.
 - c. Have a good understanding of the SHAPED profile.
 - d. Know and understand the different spiritual gifts and how they are used in ministry.
 - e. Be a servant who honors God in word and deed.
- 2. Working with Members
 - a. Serve the member personally.
 - b. Be a grand encourager.
 - c. Contact member to confirm scheduled appointment.
 - d. Meet with member to discuss and evaluate SHAPED profile.
 - e. Present each member with possible ministry fits.
 - f. Fill out G.I.F.T. form and return to PMM Coordinator.
 - g. Make follow-up phone calls to members, verifying ministry placement.

Time Commitment:

- 10 flexible hours every other month, plus initial 8 10 hours for training class and research
- 1-year commitment

Relationships: The PMM Discovery Guide works primarily with individual members who have just completed the Discovery Class. The Discovery Guide also works together with and under the PMM Coordinator, Discovery Class Coordinator and Discovery Guide Coordinator.
